Re: Movember; School Lacrosse Program by OLA

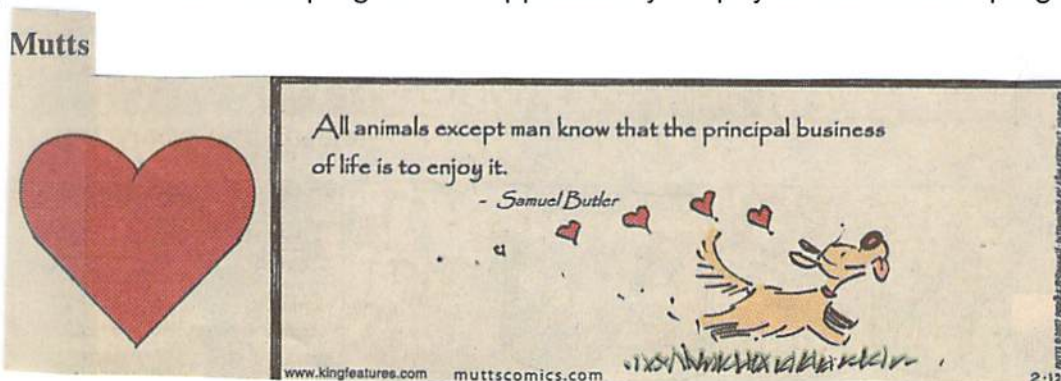
