### Pre-Budget Consultations

The Ontario government has once again launched a “Budget Talks” website, to generate ideas from Ontarians as the province prepares its budget for the coming year.

As in past years, there are several proposals to eliminate the publicly funded Catholic education system. Although the Minister of Finance has indicated that this issue is not on the table, we need Catholic teachers and others in the Catholic school community to make it clear to everyone that Catholic education works, amalgamation does not save money, and the Catholic community is united in support of the system.

The format this year is somewhat different than in past. Visitors to this website can add their own project ideas and/or agree with, question, or comment on existing proposals.

Under the focus area of “help students to achieve their full potential” two project ideas have been submitted:

2. [Spending \\$250,000 on a study](#) to assess the savings to be realized through the amalgamation of public and separate school boards.

### National Day of Remembrance and Action on Violence Against Women

The National Day of Remembrance and Action on Violence Against Women is commemorated in Canada each year on December 6. On this day in 1989, 14 young women were murdered in a tragic act of gender violence at the École Polytechnique in Montreal. This is known as the Montreal Massacre and the anniversary is marked across the nation by vigils, discussions and prayer. This day reminds us to consider the women and girls for whom violence is an everyday reality and to remember those who have died because of gender based violence.

One way to take concrete action to eliminate all forms of violence against women and girls is to raise awareness in our classrooms and schools. On behalf of the OECTA Status of Women Committee we invite you to share this information with your school representatives so they may encourage participation in this action. On December 6, it is encouraged that you include school announcements and prayers that address gender violence. For your convenience, a sample announcement and prayer for Elementary schools are included at the bottom of this memo. As well, on the OECTA website you will find *We Remember Through Action*, a commemorative resource guide for intermediate and senior grades, which provides ideas and links to classroom resources for teachers to facilitate problem solving and discussion in the classroom at <http://www.oecta.on.ca/For-Your-Classroom/Curriculum-Resources/Other>.

We also invite you to participate in the YWCA Rose Campaign. Ways of participating in this campaign are numerous: You can order buttons, posters, bookmarks, videos; you can send a message to your MP encouraging him/her to take action; you can participate in “Light the Night” on December 6, and light your school/unit office with red lights on December 6.
