

Are you retiring this year? Have you cancelled your LTD?

You can apply to terminate your LTD if you fall within one of the three scenarios below:

- You are eligible for a 60% unreduced service pension now, or you are eligible for a 60% unreduced service pension within the later of either the next 110 working days or the expiration of your sick leave to a maximum of 24 months
- Your scheduled retirement date is within the next 110 working days and you have notified both the Ontario Teachers' Pension Plan and the school board
- You have reached the end of the month in which you have turned age 65, or you will reach the end of the month in which you turned age 65 within the later of either the next 110 working days or the expiration of your sick leave to a maximum of 24 months.
