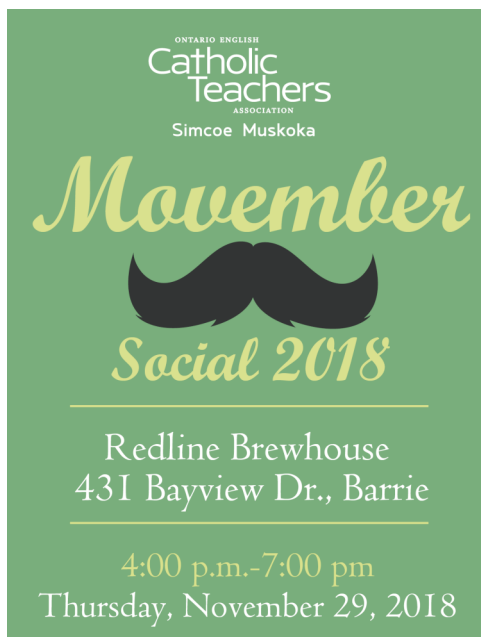

Save the date for the Simcoe Muskoka Movember Social.

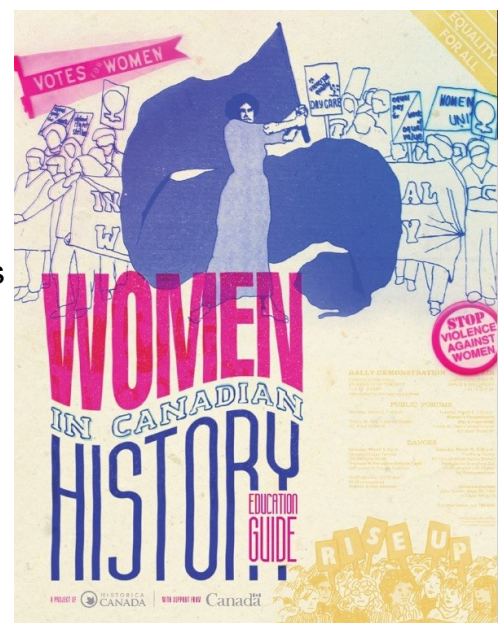

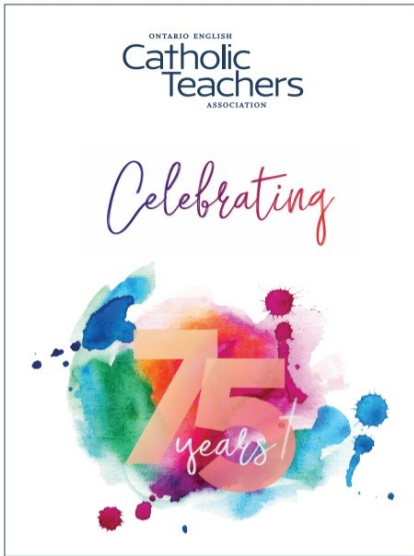
Women in Canadian History
