OTPP Pension Enhancements January 1, 2018

The contribution rate for the Plan's active members will be reduced by 1.1%

Full inflation protection will be restored for those who retired after 2009.

Also, the reduction factor has been lowered for members who cease employment in education in 2018 or later and who elect a reduced pension on a deferred basis.


## A Free Online Teacher Resource


