Second Round Transfers

The second round of transfers will be open tomorrow, June 2nd.

New this year, members will be placed based upon qualifications and seniority. Therefore if you apply to a position, it is the expectation that you will be transferring to that opening. Please refer to the postings that will be sent out tomorrow, June 2nd (posted on Employee Connect – Under the Job Posting Icon) and note that you need not limit your transfer request to posted positions, as transfer requests will be granted as positions open. If you did apply in round one, but now wish to alter your preferences as a result of seeing the second posting of vacancies, you can fill out a new second round transfer requests or contact Danielle Thibeault (through Board Email) in Human Resources in order to update your transfer requests. Second round transfers will remain active until Aug 31st, 2017.

Staff Assignment Process provisions related to surplus placement/surplus recall continue to apply and Interim Permanent Surplus teachers will be placed in existing vacancies, no later than the second last instructional day in June.
